USAC meeting

- USAC dropped Nationals on weekend of MGP
- ATRA trip: Anna Schwinn @ National Sports Center in Blaine MN have a feeder team that is designed to recruit beginners
 - o We could use the same model to increase women's racing
 - This is part of the panel on women's cycling, we are going to set up a meeting to nuderstand how to increase race numbers
- If we book 30 nights of hotel stays in Redmond with the Redmond Town Center, they will give us 1 free day. This is not much but could be used to potentially negotiate deals for racers coming in from out of town
- Finances of USAC, overall lose about \$1 million a year
 - o Revamping next year:
 - Going to \$10 day licenses
 - Won't be a charge for being a race director
- Kristian on a committee to focus on how ATRA members can be tracked as they go to another velodrome, like the USAC license system
 - There is an insurance issue to this, if a (e.g.) Cat 4 ends up racing in a Cat 1/2 field and causes a crash
- Insurance per person is going up to \$3.80 per person rather than \$3.60
