Open Track Expectations

- The Jerry Baker Memorial Velodrome is in King County's Marymoor Park. It is a public park open to all.
- The track is open when the park is open (dawn-dusk) and any additional times the MVA has scheduled.
- When either "open track" or no other event is scheduled, track use is unmonitored: free open track time
- Open to everyone with a track bike
- Equal opportunity to all on the track regardless of group size
- Communicate with other groups about track usage
- If doing standing starts you need to use a flagger and communicate with others prior to starting
- No headphones
- Please put out the new safety A-board (located under judges stand) by the bleachers and return upon finishing
- No motorized vehicles at any time
- Electric Bicycle may be used during scheduled e-pacing time and impromptu sessions at the race director's discretion. Impromptu sessions cannot be during popular times, all riders must have unlimited passes and there must be very few riders on the track. Refer to the e-pacing guidelines for more details.
- If people on road bikes or kids are passing by and want to ride please be courteous and try to let them take a lap or two in between efforts. If it is too busy please educate them on track bikes and invite them to take a class or to come watch the racing!
