

Important changes/additions:


- Wednesday Night Changes
 - Cat 4 Masters Riders can achieve upgrade points on Wednesday's in the Master B Category. With no gear restriction!
 - 1st and 3rd Wednesday will start with a training/practice madison
- No more feature races in nightly omniums
- Season Competitions are back
 - Junior C, Juniors D, Master Bs, Women 4, Men 4 and Men 3 will use the traditional scoring system based on omnium placing
 - M1/2 & W1/2/3 will have a new Rider Of The Year Competition.
